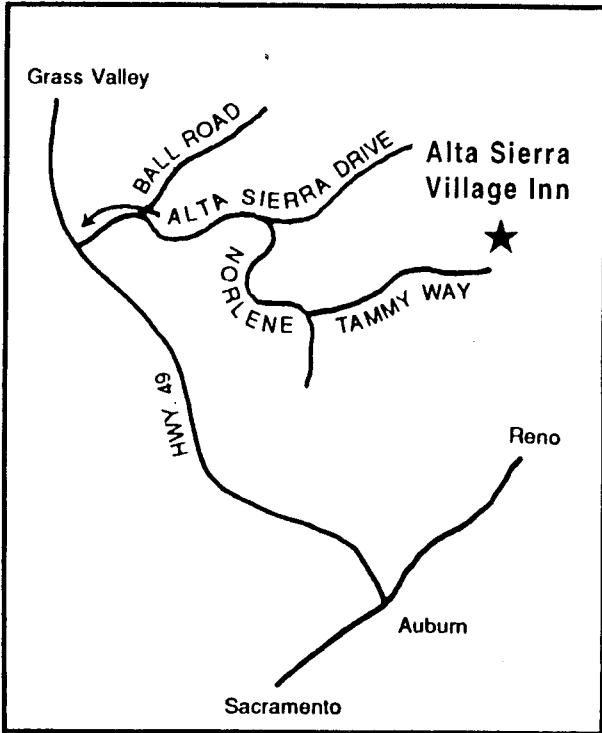

The Alta Sierra Village Inn is tucked away in the beautifully wooded Sierra foothills, just an hour from Sacramento, two hours from San Francisco, Tahoe, and Reno.

Most rooms have private decks overlooking Gold Lake and the 18th fairway of the Alta Sierra Country Club.

AREA ATTRACTIONS

Grass Valley's Gold Rush days still linger in, making sight-seeing in the area a unique experience.

The Empire Mine is one of the oldest, largest and richest mines in California. Panning for gold along the many rivers is a favorite pastime of tourists as well as local residents and can prove to be quite lucrative.

The area abounds in old Victorian houses. There are tours through many of these homes. the nostalgia of the 1880s manifests itself in the many antique shops throughout the area.

The historic buildings in Grass Valley and Nevada City have been restored to their original splendor and house many interesting shops, restaurants, museums and theaters.

Nevada County enjoys four seasons. Fall brings a bright profusion of colors as the leaves change. Winters are mild and sunny, but an occasional light snow can create a magical winter wonderland at times. Skiing is only an hour away.

Special events include: The Annual Spring Art Show, The Antique Show and Sale, and the Memorial Day Run in May; the Gold Country Marathon, Miner's Picnic, the Father's Day Bicycle Classic, and the Classical Music Festival in June.

The County Fair is held in August and is a five day event that has all the charm of the old-time fairs.
